That is why I am asking for your vote in this election. I am proud of my community and I am proud of the accomplishments that we have made.

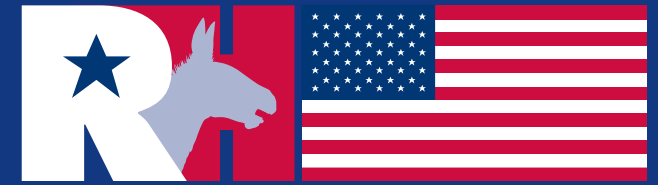
I hope that you will give me the chance to serve our great community again.
